II. PUBLIC COMMENT:

Tim Henderson, faculty member and English Co-Department Chair, delivered a one page document from Olivia Castro, his Co-Department Chair, and himself, to the Board regarding closed session item B and asked, if possible, that Board members review it at the appropriate time during closed session.

III. PRESENTATION ITEMS

A. Budget Update- Greg Wood

Greg Wood explained that the May revised California state budget update would be released on May 16th. He expects that ADA funding level information will be available a few days later. So that there is time for analysis, the all day Budget & Finance Aldersgate retreat will be pushed back one week, to May 31st.

Current projections call for a \$400,000 PCHS 2010-2011 budget surplus. Projections for the 2011-2012 are very preliminary until the ADA funding levels are known, but at this time Greg Wood is estimating a \$850,000 budget deficit. While unlikely, an "all-cuts" budget could result in a 2011-2012 PCHS budget deficit of \$2.1 million. News last week of higher than expected state revenue was positive, but a large projected state budget deficit remains. Legally, PCHS must submit a budget to the state by June 30th.

B. <u>Board Approval of Resolution # 2010-2011-002 Authorizing a Reduction or Elimination of Certain Classified Services.</u>

Michael Smith explained the calculation of the recommendation to RIF 4.5 classified employees was based on the percentage of RIF'ed certificated employees.

PCHS has approximately:

Total employees- 330.

120 certificated staff- 8 teachers received Reduction in Force notices.
60 classified staff- 4.5 classified will receive Reduction in Force notices.

Unlike certificated employees, classified employees can be laid off with only 45 days notice. There is considerably more flexibility in managing the size of the classified employees than the certificated employees.

Jason Cutler moved the Board approve Resolution #2010-2011-002 authorizing a reduction or elimination of certain classified services. The motion was seconded by Susan Frank.
