- 1. State Cuts Impact to 2011-2012 Budget \$13 lower ADA. These state cuts translate to approximately \$40,000 less revenue for the year.
- 2. 2011-2012 Budget Update ADA dropped down, we're back to our budgeted ADA; Federal Revenue updates (Teacher Quality lower, some others higher). Overall, current projected reserve addition of \$99,318.
